


# Aim

Road Safety is information that wants to help people learn how to stay safe on roads.




# How Can You Stay Safe on and near Roads?

# Stay Safe, Spread the Word


Find a safe place to cross.


STOP just before the kerb.

LOOK and LISTEN for traffic.

Be patient, let traffic pass.

Walk across when it's clear, don't run.
