⁷A time to **tear**, and a time to _ _ _ _ _ ; a time to keep _ _ _ _ _ , and a time to **speak**;

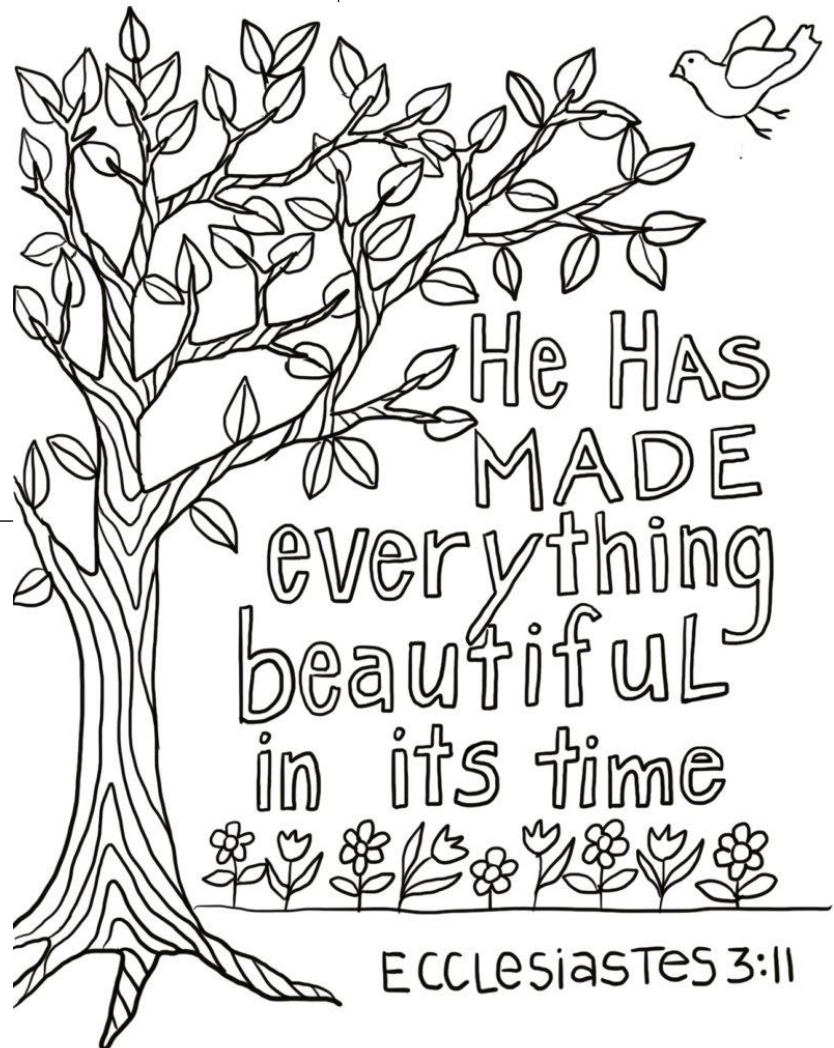
⁸A time to _ _ _ _ _ , and a time to **hate**; a time of **war**, and a time of _ _ _ _ _ .
