<p>Pick an OUTSIDE meeting place</p> <p>mail box (meeting place)</p> <p>So you can make sure EVERYONE got out safe</p>	<p>Once you safely get OUTSIDE NEVER EVER EVER run back INSIDE</p> <p>* not for nothing *</p> <p>* not even your pet *</p> <p>* or your favorite plaything *</p>
